

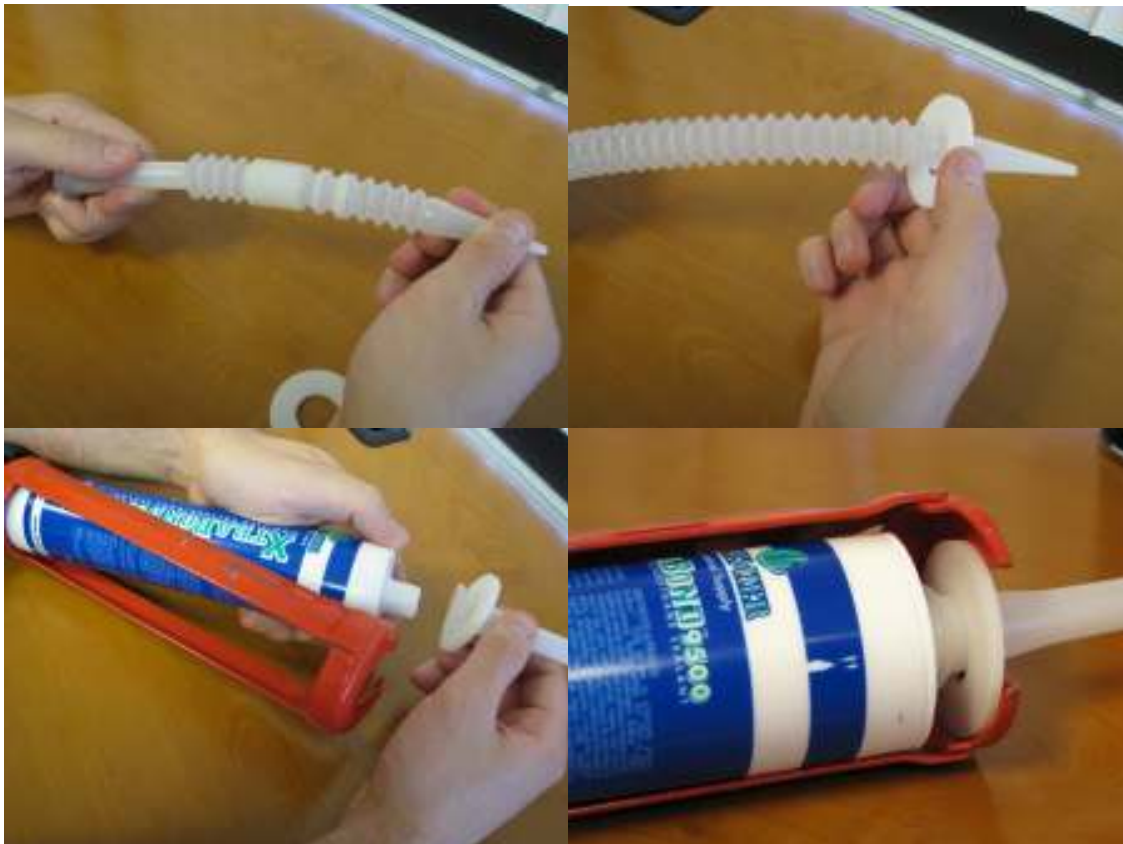
## **USING CAULK-TUBE EXTENSIONS AND HOOKS**

There are many types of caulk-tube tip shapes and caulk tube sizes. We have designed the extensions to be easily adaptable to them.

**PREPARING:** First cut the caulking tip. Cut to a length which best fits the CAULK-TUBE EXTENSION. After fitting, puncture the membrane inside the caulk tube several times (to allow the caulk to flow), and apply the tip.



**SECURING THE FIT:** In this step you expand the extension and then slip the support washer over it. Finally, slip the assembly into your caulking gun. The washer & tube fits larger 1-quart guns as well. The pressure created in the gun holds the tube tight to prevent leakage. Washer can be reused permanently.



**USING CAULK-TUBE-1 EXTENSION:** Just bend and stretch to length as needed. Cut the tip to create any bead size you want (from 0.04 to 0.6).

You can create any angle or multiple bends, and also stretch to provide up to 12 inches in extra reach. Stronger support for odd angles can be made by wrapping a wire around the extension or adding a piece of bent metal duct-taped to it.



**JOINING 2 OR MORE TUBES:** The extensions can be fit together in multiples to create very long reaches. To secure, wrap a few layers of duct tape after joining.

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
